**Grading:** The grade will be based on homework assignments, quizzes, in class assignments, 3 in-class midterm exams, and a final exam. The grade will be determined as follows:

Homework, Quizzes, In class assignments 20%  
Midterm 1 18%  
Midterm 2 18%  
Midterm 3 18%  
Final Exam 26%

The cutoffs for the letter grades A, B, C, and D will be 88%, 76%, 64%, and 52% respectively. The dates for the exams are listed in the important dates section. The lowest 5 scores from the homework/quiz/in class assignments category will be dropped.

**Attendance and make-up exams:** Students who miss class are responsible for all material covered in class. Make-up exams will be allowed only with

a valid excuse and should be taken within a few days of the missed exam. The midterm and final exam dates are listed in the important dates section. Please let me know as soon as possible if you have a conflict with one of the exams. There will be no make-ups for quizzes or in class assignments and no late homeworks accepted. Because of this no make-up policy, some of these smaller assignment grades will get dropped. You will not know ahead of time which days there will be quizzes or in class assignments, so you should keep up with the course material and plan on attending class regularly.
