Material Covered: The course will cover most sections of chapters 1-7. We will be following the math department's suggested weekly outline of topics which will be posted on D2L.

Grading: The grade will be based on weekly homework assignments, 3 inclass midterm exams, and a final exam. The grade will be determined as follows:

Attendance and make-up exams: Students who miss class are responsible for all material covered in class. Make-up exams will be allowed only

with a valid excuse and should be taken within a few days of the scheduled exam date. Please let me know as soon as possible if you have a conflict with one of the exams.

Policies on Homework: There will be weekly homework assignments posted on D2L. Assignments will usually be due on Mondays, although the first homework will be due on a Wednesday as there is no class on Monday January 21. The assignments will cover material from the previous week of classes and will be collected in class. Homework can also be turned in during office hours on the day it is due. There will be about 15 assignments and the lowest 3 homework grades will be dropped. No late homework will be accepted. If you are going to miss class, you can hand in homework early by putting it under the door to my office. Please make sure your assignments are stapled and have your name on them. Also make sure to write legibly and show your work. You may work with others on homework as long as everyone writes up their own solutions.

Calculator Policy: Calculators will not be allowed on exams. They may be used on homework assignments, but try not to become dependent on them.
